

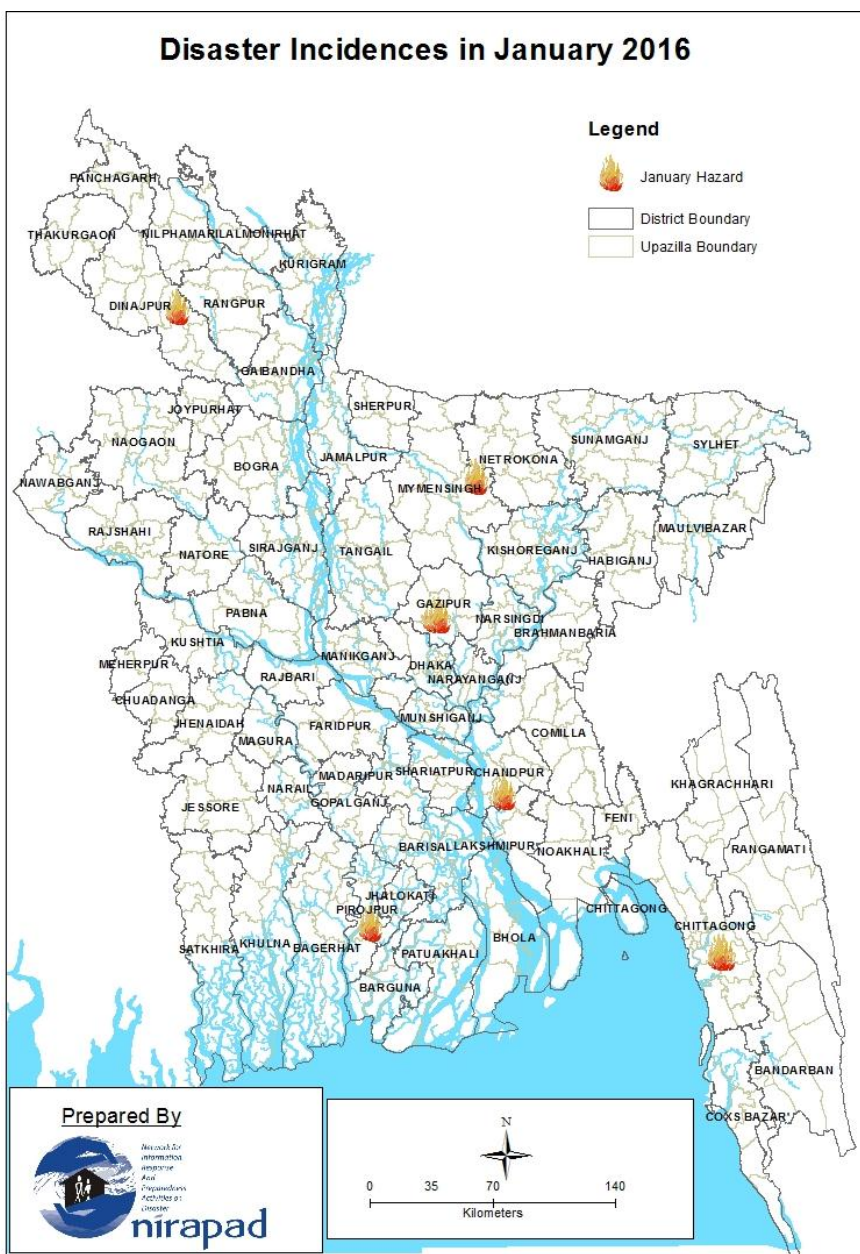


Overview of Hazard Incidences in January 2016

Several incidents of fire have been reported in the month of January, 2016. Fire incidents occurred in six districts in this month. No other hazard incidents except fire have been during this month.

Fire Incidents

Nine incidents of fire were reported in six districts (Chittagong, Pirojpur, Mymensingh, Gazipur, Chandpur and Dinajpur). These incidences of fire gutted around 22 houses and 41 shops and killed 5 people. Estimated losses were of more than BDT 4 crore.
