


Overview of Hazard Incidents in July 2018


In the month of July 2018, eight hazards have been occurred with the total frequency of 54 among which 3 types were manmade (fire, boat-capsize, building collapse) and 5 were natural (lightning, heavy rainfall, flood, flash flood, and landslide). These hazard incidents took lives of 26 persons and injured about 19 people.

One of the most devastating hazards was flood which occurred in 12 districts of northern, north-eastern and southeastern part of the country with huge damage of assets and marooned thousands of people. Another devastating hazard was landslide which took 9 lives as highest death caused by this hazard. Also, lightening caused death of 7 people with 5 incidents in 4 districts.

Fire was also remarkable in terms of frequency of 8 incidents in 6 districts. Fire incident injured 2 persons in the foam industry in Gazipur. Another frequently occurred hazard was heavy rainfall at 6 times in Chattogram, Dhaka, Kurigram and Lalmonirhat which caused waterlogging in Chattogram and Dhaka.

Along with these, the incidents of flash flood took place in 3 districts with the disruption of daily life but no death was reported so far. Also, four incidents of building collapse in two districts caused death of 4 persons and injured 9 persons; and boat capsize occurred twice in this month with the death of 6 persons and 5 injured.

Description of the Hazard Incidences in July 2018

Lightening

Lightening occurred in five upazilas under four districts which are situated in the northern, middle and the north western part of the country. At Sadullahpur in Gaibandha, one woman and two children died in lightening. Another two several incidents of lightening at two upazilas named Raiganj and Belkuchi under Sirajganj district took two lives. On the 24th July two people also died at Dhunat and Alamdanga in different two incidents. In total seven people died in lightening in the month of July.

Boat capsize

On the 2nd and 10th July two incidents of boat-capsize occurred in Sunamganj and Narayanganj. In Sunamganj two people, including a woman, were killed and five others injured as a boat capsized due to strong waves of Jorsingha haor. The second incidents of boat capsize caused 4 people dead in Narayanganj.

<u>Landslide</u>

Landslide occurred from heavy rainfall in the south-east part of the country in Bandarban and Cox's Bazar due to landslide total 9 persons died and 3 injured In Cox's Bazar 5 houses and 2 shops destroyed and 15 other families were affected. In the month of July landslide was the most lives taking hazard incident.

<u>Flood</u>

Total 12 districts of the country were flooded in 20 incidents during the month of July among them of the northern districts of Bogura, Gaibandha, Kurigram, Panchagarh , Lalmonirhat, Nilphamary, Sirajganj, Panchagarh and east- northern districts of Sylhet, Sunamgang, Moulvibazar and south-eastern districts of Bandarban and Cox's Bazar were affected. Flood was most devastating in July, 2018. In Bandarban the overflowing of Sangu River has left the roads leading to Rangamati and Chattogram from Bandarban inundated. Flood occurs twice in Sylhet in the month of July. Kurigram, Lalmonirhat and Nilphamari were affected mostly in the earlier of the month. Damage, distress and disruption occurs because people marooned, crop damaged and roads are inundated.

<u>Fire</u>

Fire occurred in 6 districts with 8 incidents. Highest number of fire occurred in Gazipur district and 2 industrial workers were injured in a fire incident at a foam industry and 3 shops burnt in two several incidents. In Dhaka Fire occurred at Bangabazar. Another large amount of loss of 30 lakhs decoration of Mymensigh Agriculture University was burnt. In Nilphamari at Sayedpur railway workshop a train carriage Burnt

Building Collapse

In two districts 4 incidents of building collapse occurred and among these 3 incidents occurred in Dhaka District. In roof collapse at Saghata upazila 1 person died and 9 got injured at central jail located at Keraniganj. Along with this two children died in wall collapse at Dohar, another construction worker died in lift collapse. In total 4 people died and 9 people injured.

Flash Flood

Flash fold occurred in 3 districts because of heavy rainfall. Flash flood damaged 146 houses which affected 6672 people of Lalmonirhat and disruption of road network was occurred in Bandarban and distress 12000 family of Chattogram.

Heavy Rainfall

Dhaka and Chattogram with nonstop heavy rainfall was reported at the end of the month which results waterlogging in both major city of the country. Kajipara, Motijhil, Tejgaon, Kawran Bazjar and different areas of Dhaka city was waterlogged and somewhere boat was used as alternative transportation. 30 unions of Kurigram district were inundated. Also, some roads of Agrabad and Halishahar were inundated in Chattogram.

GOB Responses in July 2018

Response to Flood: Mr. Mofazzal Hossain Chowdhury (Maya) Bir Bikram, MP, honorable Minister, MoDMR; informed in a press briefing that as early preparedness of flood 75,000 packets of dry foods were sent to 35 flood prone districts and from 1 July to 10th July BDT 11,200,000 and 5,500 ton GR rice were distributed among the 64 districts. He also informed that 50,000 bundle of CI sheets and BDT 150,000,000 is allotted for the repairing of the damaged house and new house building. Disaster Management Department reserves 1,000 ton rice and BDT 20,000,000 for emergency response. Along with this each district has allotted with 150 -200 ton and BDT 300,000 -500,000.

Response to Landslide: Each family of the dead persons were given BDT 25,000 and BDT 5,000 for the treatment of injured by district relief fund and Minster of Relief informed that 25-50 thousands of vulnerable Rohingya are identified and the ministry to shift them in a safe place process is going on. Already 30 to 35 thousands of families are shifted to shelter.

Response to Lightning: Each family of the dead persons was given BDT 10,000 by the district fund of Disaster Management and Relief.

Conclusion

Especially lightening and landslide frequency was comparatively low in the month of July than previous month June; another devastating hazard was flash flood which has been decreased in frequency than June, 2018. Death caused by Building collapse and boat capsize was mentionable. Although the highest lives taking hazard was land slide, the damages and disruptions caused by flood, flash flood, heavy rainfall was high in amount. However, the Government undertook response interventions for flood, landslide and lightning affected people.
