


Overview of Hazard Incidents in May, 2019

In May 2019, nine devastating hazards took place across Bangladesh including fire, wild animal attack, lightning, nor'wester, cyclone, boat capsize, landslide, building collapse and bridge collapse.

The mostly occurred hazard of this month was fire with 20 incidents in 14 districts correspondingly Sylhet, Gazipur, Barishal, Rangpur, Lakhshmipur, Chattogram, Kurigram, Natore, Cumilla, Sirajganj, Dhaka, Gazipur, Sherpur and Panchagarh.

Lightning took place in 14 districts, i.e. Kishoreganj, Netrokona, Kushtia, Naogaon, Chapainawabganj, Gazipur, Cox's Khagrachhari, Bazar, Brahmanbaria. Habiganj, Sirajganj, Rajshahi Pirojpur, Cumilla and correspondingly with 17 incidents.

Cyclone "FANI" took place in 28 districts with a huge loss of lives and properties. Also, nor' wester occurred in seven districts, i.e. Bagerhat, Netrokona, Dhaka, Naogaon, Thakurgaon, Tangail and Bogura.

Description of the Hazard Incidents in May, 2019

<u>Fire</u>

14 districts i.e. Sylhet, Gazipur, Barishal, Rangpur, Lakhshmipur, Chattogram, Kurigram, Natore, Cumilla, Sirajganj, Dhaka, Gazipur, Sherpur and Panchagarh faced 20 incidents of fire in May 2019, which killed nine persons and injured 13 persons along with estimated loss of BDT 1 crore 10 lakhs. Dhaka and Chattogram had faced the highest number of incidents (three in each) in May, 2019. A massive fire incident took place in Rangpur on May 07, 2019 which killed 7,000 cocks with estimated loss of BDT 14 lakhs. Another incident took place in Rangpur on the same day in which five cows killed. In Natore, on May 17, 2019, four shops and one godown burnt with an estimated loss of BDT 45 lakhs. Another devastating incident occurred in Gazipur on May 22, 2019 which killed four persons of the same family.

Wild animal attack

Three districts, i.e. Chattogram, Rangamati and Khagrachhari were affected by five incidents of wild animal attack in May, 2019 which killed three persons and injured two persons. Four of the attacks were from wild elephants in Chattogram on May 01, 07 and 13, 2019 in Khagrachhari on May 26, 2019 and one was from black bear in Rangamati on May 12, 2019 which had seriously injured one person.

<u>Lightning</u>

Lightning took place in 14 districts, i.e. Kishoreganj, Netrokona, Kushtia, Naogaon, Chapainawabganj, Gazipur, Cox's Bazar, Khagrachhari, Brahmanbaria, Sirajganj, Habiganj, Pirojpur, Cumilla and Rajshahi correspondingly with 17 incidents in May, 2019 which killed 26 persons, injured seven persons and killed one cow. In Kishoreganj, on May 03, 2019 six persons were killed in three different incidents. A devastating incident took place in Cox's Bazar on May 19, 2019 which killed two persons and injured four persons. Another incident took place in Khagrachhari on the same day which killed two persons, injured three persons and killed one cow.

Nor'wester


Nor'wester took place in seven districts, i.e. Bagerhat, Netrokona, Dhaka, Naogaon, Thakurgaon, Tangail and Bogura in May, 2019 which killed six persons and injured 43 persons; damaged around 200 houses, uprooted trees, damaged crops and fruits, and disrupted electricity.

Cyclone "FANI"

Cyclone "FANI" was generated as a deep depression and then intensified into extremely severe cyclonic storm at southwest and adjoining southeast Bay of Bengal at end of April, 2019. It made landfall on May 03, 2019 along the Odisha coast and then crossed Bangladesh through the mid-western part on May 04, 2019 in a dissipated form without causing major damage (NAWG-Bangladesh, 2019).

28 districts, i.e. Khulna, Satkhira, Bagerhat, Pirojpur, Barguna, Patuakhali, Barishal, Bhola, Noakhali, Lakshmipur, Feni, Chattogram, Cox's Bazar, Jhalakathi, Chandpur, Madaripur, Shariatpur, Gopalganj, Faridpur, Jashore, Magura, Narail, Jhenaidah, Kushtia, Chuadanga, Meherpur, Sirajganj and Sunamganj

faced the cyclone "FANI" which killed 10 persons, injured 833 persons, killed 175 domestic animals, damaged 2,363 houses fully and 18,670 houses partially, damaged crop of 1,830 acres fully and 1,53,832 acres partially, damaged 21.95 Km of embankment at 240 places, inundated 59 villages, damaged 129 electric poles and disrupted electricity supply to 81,06,500 households. The estimated overall loss of BDT 536.61 core have been reported due to cyclone "FANI".

Boat capsize

A boat capsized in the Brahmaputra which was departed for Dhutichora village from Noyagram of Gaibandha Sadar upazila with 50 passengers on May 07, 2019. Among the all 50 passengers of the boat, 41 managed to reach the bank but three persons were killed and six persons were missing (*https://www.prothomalo.com*, May 07, 2019).

<u>Landslide</u>

In a Rohingya camp of Balukhali, Ukhiya, Cox's Bazar, the only incident of landslide took place on May 11, 2019 which killed two children of the same family (*https://bangla.dhakatribune.com*, May 11, 2019).

Building collapse

Dhaka and Rajshahi faced two incidents of building collapse on May 17, 2019 which killed three persons. In Dhaka, two persons were killed due to collapse of the side-wall of a building while passing by it (*https://www.prothomalo.com*, May 17, 2019) and in Rajshahi, one person killed due to wall collapse of a house (*NDRCC report*, May 18, 2019).

Bridge collapse

Tangail faced the only incident of bridge collapse on May 18, 2019 in which Baily bridge of the Tangail-Basail route partially damaged and communication disrupted between the Basail and Tangail Sadar (*https://www.prothomalo.com*, May 18, 2019).

GoB Response in May 2019

Responses to cyclone "FANI": A total of 16,66,043 people were relocated to the cyclone shelters of the concerned areas by the local administrative bodies. 3,800 metric ton GR rice, BDT 1 core 97 lakhs as GR cash and 41,000 packets dry food were distributed in 19 affected districts. Honorable State Minister, Senior Secretary of MoDMR and Chief Secretary of Prime Minister's Office made video conference with District Commissioners of 19 coastal districts. A meeting of Disaster Management Coordination Committee was also conducted for undertaking further actions.

Responses to boat capsize: BDT 10,000 was given to each family of the dead persons by the district administration on May 07, 2019 in Gaibandha Sadar upazila.

Response to fire: Two bundles of tin and BDT 6,000 has been given to the affected family on May 07, 2019 by the Pirganj upazila administration of Rangpur.

Response to lightning: BDT 20,000 was given to each family of the dead persons by the district administration on May 17, 2019 in Chapainawabganj and Gazipur. The affected family of the dead person received BDT 20,000 on May 26, 2019 by the Panchagarh Sadar upazila administration of Panchagarh. BDT 15,000 was given to the family of the dead person by the district administration on May 27, 2019 in Cumilla.

Conclusion

A total of nine hazards took place in this month with several incidents across the country. These incidents caused a huge loss of lives and properties and disrupted daily activities of people. GoB took initiatives to minimize the losses and also undertook necessary actions to provide support to the distressed people.
