



Overview of Hazard Incidents in October 2020

In October 2020, nine devastating hazards took place across Bangladesh i.e. Covid-19 pandemic, fire, lightning, boat capsized, building collapse, bridge collapse, landslide, earthquake and waterlogging.

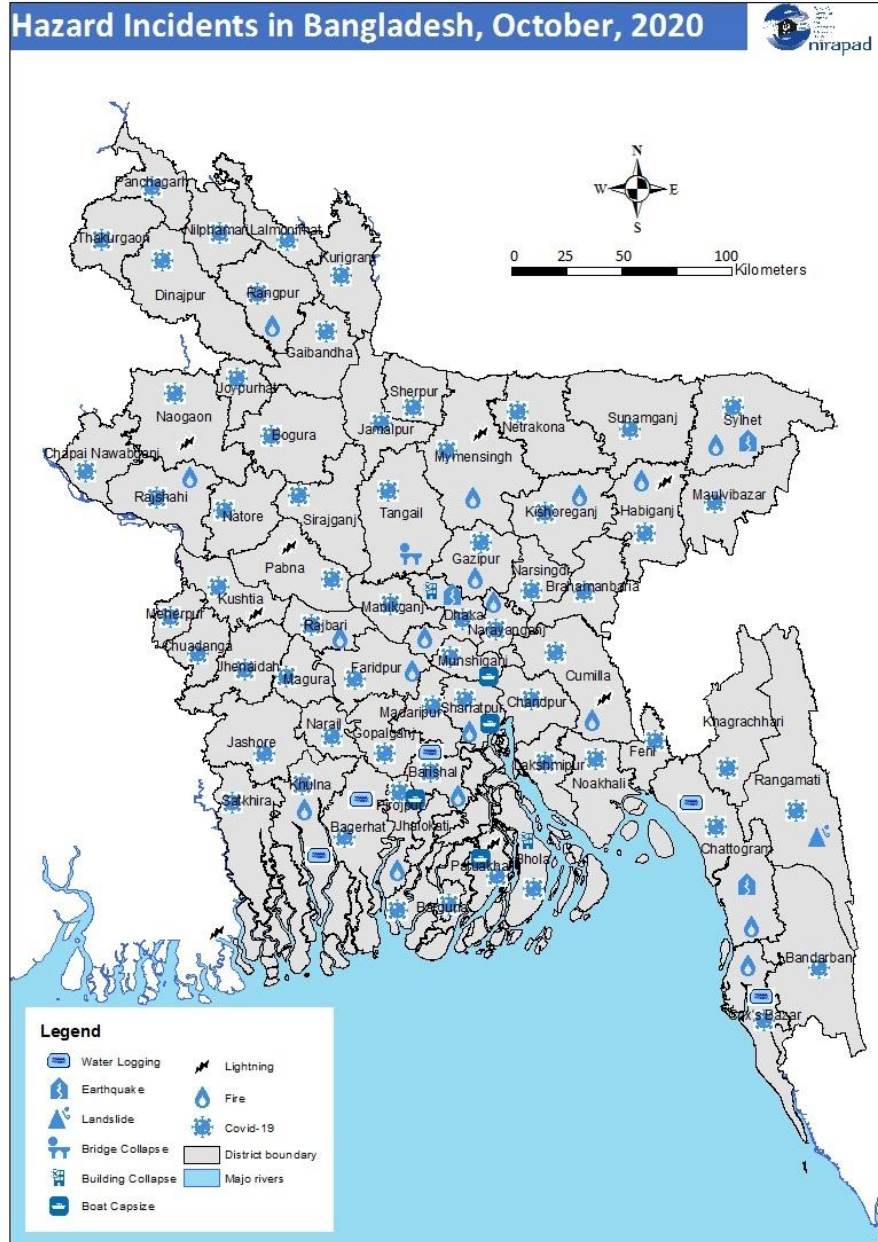
In October 2020, Covid-19 affected a total of 44,205 persons across the country among which 672 persons died and 48,658 persons recovered. From March 08, 2020 to October 31, 2020, the total number of Covid-19 patient is 407,684 among which 5,923 persons died and 324,135 persons recovered.

31 incidents of fire took place in October, 2020 which killed 9 persons and injured 44 persons. However NDRCC reported 376 incidents throughout the country

in which Dhaka division faced 152 incidents and Chattogram division faced 53 incidents of fire.

Lightning took place in 8 districts with 9 incidents in which 10 persons killed and 1 persons injured. Boat capsized took place in 4 districts with 4 incidents in which 5 persons were killed and 2 persons were missing. 4 incidents of building collapse took place in 2 districts i.e. Dhaka and Bhola which killed 2 persons and injured 17 persons.

Only two incidents of bridge collapse took place both in Tangail in which 1 person injured. The only incident of landslide happened in Rangamati which disrupts communication. One incident of earthquake took place in Dhaka, Chattogram and Sylhet which is of 5.4 magnitude. No impacts reported in this event. Two incidents of waterlogging happened where many low-lying areas of Bagerhat, Khulna, Barisal, Chattogram and Cox's Bazar went under water.

Description of Hazard Incidents in October 2020

Covid-19 Pandemic in Bangladesh

The Covid-19 pandemic had affected with high impacts throughout this month in all the 64 districts across Bangladesh. In October, 2020, the number of identified patients with Covid-19 is 44,205 persons among which 48,658 persons recovered and 672 persons died. From the very first case identified in March 2020, the total number of Covid-19 patient is 4,076,484 among which 5,923 persons died and 3,24,145 persons recovered up to October 31, 2020. Though government has taken steps to minimize movement of people but the situation may become worsen if health guidelines by the Director General of Health Services (DGHS) are not maintained properly.

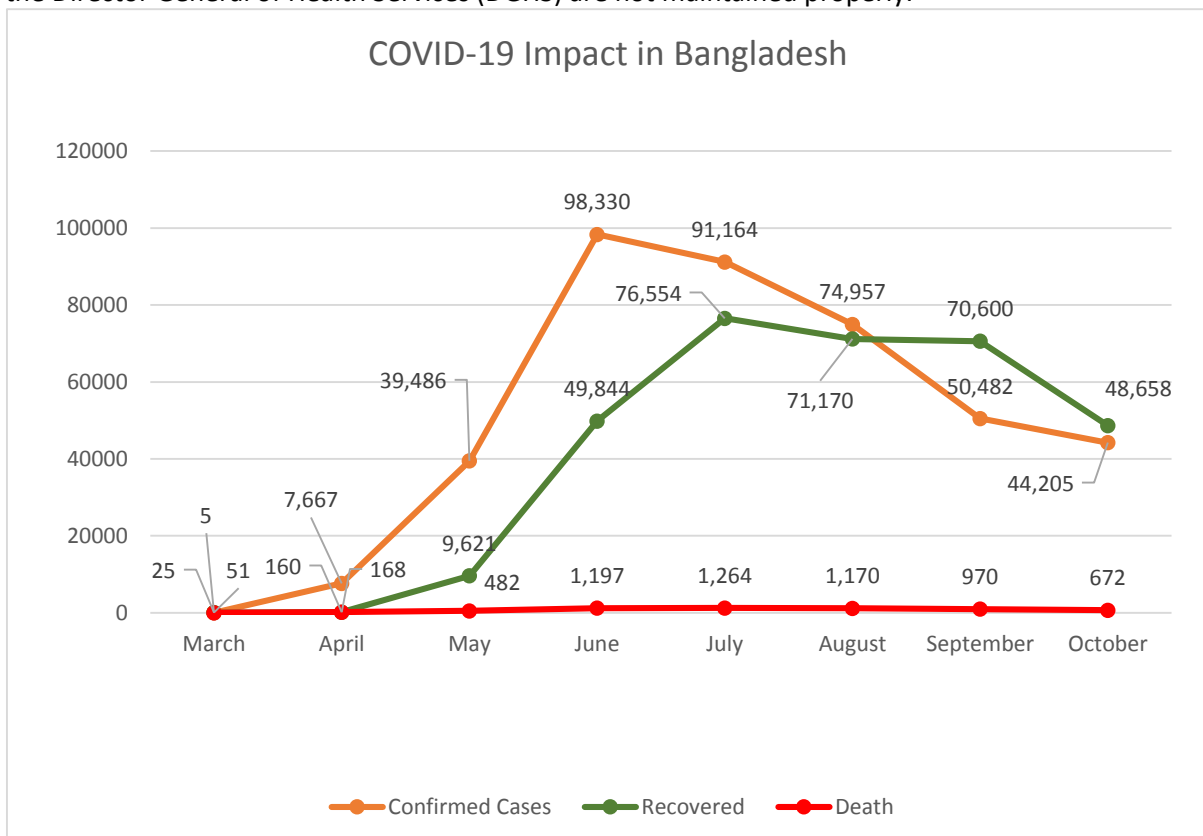

Fire

In October, 2020, 31 incidents of fire took place which killed 9 persons and injured 44 persons. However NDRCC reported 376 incidents throughout the country in which Dhaka division faced 152 incidents and Chattogram division faced 53 incidents of fire. In Rupganj Upazila under Narayanganj district, on October 23, 2020, 4 persons were killed and 6 persons injured.

Boat capsizes

4 incidents of boat capsizes took place in 4 districts, i.e. Pirojpur, Shariatpur, Patuakhali and Munshiganj in which 5 persons killed and 2 persons missing. In Rangabali upazila under Patuakhali district, on October 20, 2020 an incident of boat capsizes took place where 5 persons were killed.

Building Collapse

Bridge Collapse

Landslide

Earthquake

A 5.4 magnitude earthquake felt in Dhaka, Chattogram and Sylhet Division on October 10, 2020. No impacts reported in this event. (Source: <https://modmr.gov.bd>)

Waterlogging

Many low-lying areas of Chattogram city including No. 2 Gate, Agrabad, Prabartak circle, Chawkbazar, Muradpur, Shulakbahar, Bahadderhat, Pahartali, Kalamia Bazar, Kalurghat, Chandgaon and Bakalia went underwater on 23 October, 2020. The water entered some low-lying residential houses and business firms leaving the people marooned. On October 24, 2020, low lying areas of Sarankhola, Morrelganj, Rampal, Sarankhola, Sadar, Chilmari, Fakirhat, and Mongla upazilas in Bagerhat district and Numerous villages in Khulna, Barishal, Chattogram, and Cox's Bazar district have been submerged where 9,761 shrimp and fish enclosures worth BDT 5.4 crore have been washed away and thousands of families marooned. GoB Response in October 2020

Response to Covid-19 up to October 31, 2020: The mass people have been guided to maintain social distance in workplaces, public transports, and religious institutions and avoid any kind of public gatherings. DGHS has prepared guidelines for the organizations (both public and private) to be

maintained during working hours. DGHS and IEDCR have undertaken necessary steps to test Covid-19 suspected patients in the test labs across the country which have already tested 23,36,262 samples as of October 31, 2020. A total of 11,608 general beds, 564 Intensive care unit (ICU) beds, 13,095 Oxygen cylinders, 574 high flow nasal cannula, and 363 oxygen concentrator are available in the hospitals across the country. DGHS and IEDCR have opened up hotline number (i.e. 16263, 333, 10655, 01927711784, 01927711785, 01937000011, 01937110011) for consultation with doctors through phone calls which already have attended to 22,271,847 phone calls. Screening have been conducted of 11,14,071 persons in airports, railway stations, sea port and land ports. (Source: DGHS Health Bulletin, October 31, 2020).

Response to Waterlogging:

2,000 packets of dry food were distributed among the affected people by the local authorities in Bagerhat district on October 24, 2020.

Response to Lightning:

Killed person's family received BDT 20,000 and injured person's family received 10,000 BDT cash support from Local authorities on October 19, 2020.

Conclusion

A total of nine hazards took place in this month with several incidents across the country. These incidents caused a huge loss of lives and properties and disrupted daily activities of people. GoB took initiatives to minimize the losses and also undertook necessary actions to provide support to the distressed people.
