
Disaster Incidences in Bangladesh in October, 2015



Overview of Disaster Incidences in October, 2015


Disaster incidents in October include only two types of hazards i.e. riverbank erosion and fire. Riverbank erosion was the most common incident in October. Incidents of riverbank erosion were reported especially in the 1st quarter of the month as well on October 17 and 31. Fire incidents occurred in 3 places on October 1 and 16.



Riverbank Erosion

Riverbank erosion that started in September in Lalmonirhat continued until October 2. Some 200 households lost their houses and became shelter-less. Riverbank erosion also occurred in the 1st week of October in Islampur (Jamalpur district) and Komol Nagar (Laxmipur district). It devoured more than 250 houses several shops, large area of cropland and many trees.

Fire

3 incidents were occurred in Comilla and Netrokona districts which gutted about 50 establishments including shops and houses. Put together the estimated loss amounted to approximately BDT 14 million. Also, in Netrokona, 1 person suffered burn injury.
