










Overview of Hazard Incidents in June 2017

In June 2017, the frequency of hazard incidents was quite low but the intensity of impacts of those hazards were noteworthy. This month was impactful with natural disasters like landslides and trawler and boat capsizes and man-made disasters as fire, road accident, occurring throughout the country. Of them all, landslides occurred in June 12, had most severe impacts. Total 164 people were died in 5 affected districts namely Rangamati, Bandarban, Chittagong, Cox's Bazar and Khagrachhari. Another severe incident was road accident which took away 16 peoples life.

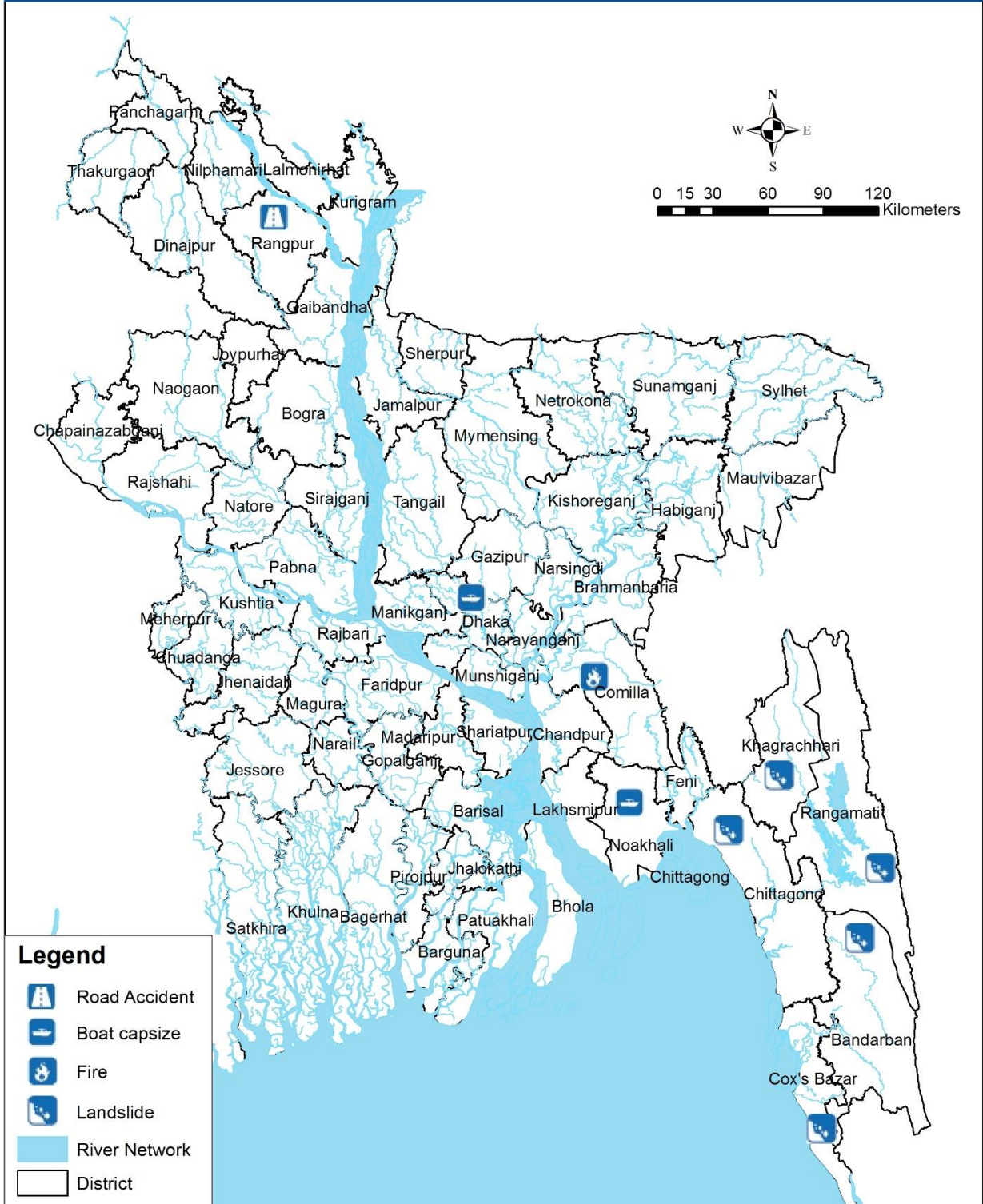
Description of the Incidents in June 2017

Landslide

Depression originated at northwest Bay of Bengal and adjacent areas causes extreme rainfall in the coastal regions on June 12, 2017 and triggered massive landslides in five districts of southeast Bangladesh i.e. Bandarban, Chittagong, Cox's Bazar, Khagrachhari, and Rangamati. About 164 people including several rescuer (officers and members of the army) have been killed by this landslides in these five districts.

Fire

Road Accident

In Pirganj of Rangpur district 16 people died due to road accident on 24 June, day before Eid-ul-Fitr.

Boat/ Trawler Capsize

On June 12, 2 people died due to a boat capsized in Meghna River at Noakhali due to storm. Another trawler capsized was took place at Dhaka on the same day.

GOB Responses in June 2017

Response in Landslide: Government of Bangladesh responded immediately landslide incident. GoB through District Relief and Rehabilitation Officer, allocated GR cash and GR rice in the affected districts (see table below). Moreover, Mr. Obaydul Quader, Minister of Road Transport and Bridge, during his visit Rangamati on 14th June, has announced BDT 5,000,000, 100 MT rice and 500 bundle of C. I. sheet for assistance of the affected people of these areas.

Response in Road Accident: Government of Bangladesh through MoDRM allocated GR cash of BDT 20,000 to each family of dead person and GR cash BDT 5,000 from MoDRM to each family of the Injured (NDRCC Report, June 24, 2017) in road accident.

Response in Boat Capsize: Government of Bangladesh allocated BDT 20,000 to each family of with dead person by the boat capsized at Meghna River through MoDRM (NDRCC Report, June 13, 2017)

Conclusion

Disaster frequency was comparatively less in the month of June. But the impact of landslide in Bandarban, Chittagong, Cox's Bazar, Khagrachhari and Rangamati was devastating. As well, there were low intensity disasters in different parts of the country e.g. boat capsized, trawler capsized, fire and road accident. Amongst the disasters, the most severe one, landslide of 12th June, was responded on priority basis by Government. Affected people of road accident and boat capsized were also responded by the Government of Bangladesh.
