

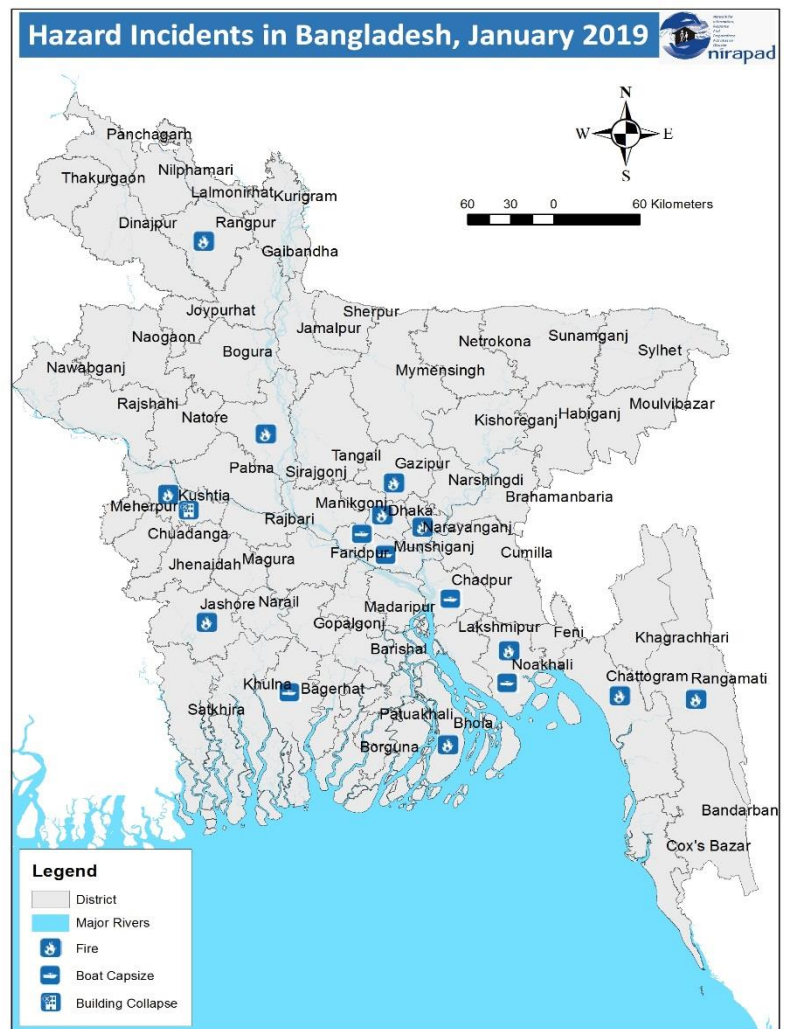
Overview of Hazard Incidents in January, 2019

January was a month of three devastating man-made hazards, i.e. fire, boat-capsize and building collapse with a total of 13, five and two incidents respectively.

Fire was the mostly occurred hazard which took place in 11 districts correspondingly Dhaka, Gazipur, Kushtia, Bhola, Rangamati, Jashore, Noakhali, Chattogram, Narayanganj, Sirajganj and Rangpur. The 13 incidents of fire injured five persons and caused monetary loss of approximately BDT 17 crore.

With five incidents in five districts, i.e. Munshiganj, Bagerhat, Noakhali, Dhaka and Chandpur; boat capsizes was the most devastating hazard of the month in terms of loss and damage to human lives. The incidents caused death of three persons and 22 persons were missing.

Along with these, two incidents of building collapse took place in Kushtia. The incidents caused death of three persons and injured five persons.

Description of the Hazard Incidents in January, 2019

Fire

Fire took place in 11 districts across the country in 10 days of the month of January. Dhaka and Gazipur have faced two incidents each in the first week of January. Among these two incidents of Gazipur on 4th January, one cotton go-down was burnt at Kaliakoir and another fire incident took place at Tongi. In an incident on 5th January which took place in Kushtia injured five persons since they were burnt in a fire caused by cylinder leakage of the kitchen in a Madrasa. Another devastating incident caused loss of BDT two crore by burning 33 shops in Bhola on 12th January. In Rangamati, 103 houses were burnt on 13th January as per the Fire Service and Civil Defense (FSCD) officers were unable to access to the incident place quickly due to narrow roads. Later FSCD, Army, Police and BGB personnel worked together to control the fire. Another incident took place in Jashore on 17th January which burnt 3,000-4,000 maunds jute and 40 tons cotton causing approximate loss of BDT 15 crore. Also, in an incident which took place in Narayanganj on 21st January, 72 houses were burnt.

Building Collapse

Building collapse occurred in Kushtia on 8th and 17th January with two separate incidents. Among the two incidents, two sisters died due to collapse of the sun-shed of an under-construction building on 8th January. The other incident caused death of one person and injured five persons on 17th January.

Boat Capsize

Boat capsizing took place in five districts with five incidents across the month of January. In Munshiganj, a soil-laden trawler collided with an oil-laden tanker and sank on 16th January. Due to the incident, 20 persons were missing among the all 34 members of the trawler. Two separate incidents took place in Chandpur on January 24th. In these two incidents, two lighter ships (one with 1,700 tons wheat & one with corns) sank in Meghna River. The most heart-touching incident occurred in Dhaka, which killed three persons of the same family along with missing of the dead parents' child on 25th January. Another incident in Chandpur caused a huge loss 800 tons fly-ash after a ship sank with a loss of BDT 85 lacs on 31st January.
