Hazard Incidents in Bangladesh, March 2020



Overview of Hazard Incidents in March, 2020

In March 2020, six devastating hazards took place across Bangladesh including Covid-19 pandemic, fire, hailstorm, lightning, boat capsize and building collapse.

In the end of the March 2020 Covid-19 pandemic is getting devastating day by day as already five persons killed, 25 persons recovered and a total of 51 has been infected in Bangladesh.

Fire took place in 11 districts i.e. Cumilla, Gopalganj, Chattogram, Dhaka. Netrokona, Narayanganj, Moulvibazar, Rangpur, Kishoreganj, Rajbari and Pirojpur with 33 incidents among which Dhaka faced six incidents of fire.

Lightning affected three districts i.e. Faridpur, Sylhet and Gaibandha with three incidents. Boat capsize took place in Rajshahi and Chandpur with two incidents.

Building collapse took place in three districts, i.e. Madaripur, Sirajganj and



Description of Hazard Incidents in March 2020

Covid-19 Pandemic in Bangladesh

The worldwide pandemic Covid-19 has become talk of the time worldwide and Bangladesh is no longer away from its ferocious effects. Up to March 31, 2020, the total number of identified Covid-19 cases is 51 persons among which 5 persons died. According to IEDCR, the chance of spreading Covid-19 is now at community level



which may lead to highly increase this number very fast. Also, the death toll may also rise if not diagnosed and treated immediately. The rising tendency in the number of infected patients may lead to a huge public health hazard in coming days. According to honorable Prime Minister of Bangladesh, H. E. Sheikh Hasina, the most crucial time for Covid-19 transmission is the month of April, 2020 and most of the people may get affected if they do not properly maintain the directions given by the government; specially, staying at home.

Fire

11 districts i.e. Cumilla, Gopalganj, Chattogram, Dhaka, Netrokona, Narayanganj, Moulvibazar, Rangpur, Kishoreganj, Rajbari and Pirojpur faced 33 incidents of fire in March 2020, which killed 12 person and injured seven persons along with estimated loss of BDT 23 lakhs. Dhaka faced the highest number of incidents (six) in March 2020. In Gopalganj, on March 01, 2020, an incident of fire killed five persons at a time. A massive fire incident took place in a slum of Mirpur under Dhaka district on March 11, 2019 which burnt more than 200 houses completely. Another incident took place in Hathazari upazila under Chattogram district on March 08, 2020 which burnt one godown, two shops, two tin-shed houses and one car with an estimated loss of BDT 18 lakhs.

Hailstorm

Hailstorm took place in all the upazilas of Faridpur on March 03, 2020 which damaged a huge amount of onion, sesame and lentil croplands leading towards heavy loss of the farmers (https://bangla.dhakatribune.com, March 03, 2020).

Lightning

Lightning took place in three districts i.e. Faridpur, Sylhet and Gaibandha in March, 2020 which killed five persons and injured six persons. In a massive incident in Sundarganj upazila under Gaibandha district on March 04, 2020, two persons were killed and four persons were injured.

Boat Capsize

Two incidents of boat capsize took place in Rajshahi and Chandpur on March 04 and March 24, 2020 correspondingly. The most heart-touching incident took place in Rajshahi on March 04, 2020 in which nine persons were killed including a newly married bride.

Building Collapse

Three districts i.e. Madaripur, Sirajganj and Narayanganj faced three incidents of building collapse in March 2020 which killed six persons and injured 13 persons. In Tarash upazila under Sirajganj district on March 19, 2020, four persons were killed and two persons were injured when the underconstruction gate of a college collapsed on them.

GoB Response in March 2020

Response to boat capsize: BDT 20,000 has been given to each killed person's family by the Rajshahi district administration on March 07, 2020.

Response to Covid-19: In the mid of March, 2020 GoB declared to close all the educational institutions to prevent spreading of Covid-19 country-wide. Also, Higher Secondary School Certificate (HSC) examination was cancelled which was to be held from April 01, 2020. After first death of Covid-19 affected patient on March 18, 2020, GoB declared general holiday across the country from March 26, 2020 to April 04, 2020. Also, the transportation system including roads, railway, water transportation, national and international flights. Institute of Epidemiology, Disease Control and Research (IEDCR) has undertaken necessary steps to test Covid-19 suspected patients and the treatment providers were provided with Personal Protection Equipment (PPE). More test kits and PPE are being arranged by GoB as soon as possible. Also, IEDCR is arranging to test Covid-19 in regional areas to find out more patients shortly. People (especially poor and ultra-poor) who are in need of foods, GoB arranged to provide foods at their doorsteps by the local administrations.

Conclusion

A total of six hazards took place in this month with several incidents across the country. These incidents caused a huge loss of lives and properties and disrupted daily activities of people. GoB took initiatives to minimize the losses and also undertook necessary actions to provide support to the distressed people.
