
Overview of Hazard Incidences in October 2021

In October 2021, **12** hazards took place across Bangladesh i.e. Covid 19, Heavy Rainfall, Lightning, Fire Incident, Boat Capsize, Flood, Riverbank erosion, Embankment collapse, Bridge Collapse, Water Logging, Wildlife Inflicted Damage, Wall Collapse. Among them, the most devastating **Covid 19** affected a total of **13,628** persons across the country. Among which **358** persons died and **17,482** persons recovered according to the national report of **October, 2021**.

Due to **flood** in the second half of the month, **6** districts reported heavy damage among them were Kurigram, Lalmanirhat, Rangpur, Tangail, Gaibandha and Faridpur. **60** kilometers of lands reported being Flooded, **38,438** families were affected according to [NDRCC](#) reports, and multiple educational and religious institutes were also damaged because of the flood.

Lightning was another severe hazard that took the life of **35** persons across **16** districts according to daily newspapers. According to [NDRCC](#) reports **404** fire incidents took place throughout the country, in which **1** people died. **Bridge collapsed** in one district and no injuries were reported. In **4** districts **9** people died and **16** people were reported missing in October due to **boat capsizes** incidents.

Riverbank erosion took place in Satkhira, Gopalganj, Faridpur, Kushtia districts causing widespread damage to lives, properties, crops and croplands. **Heavy rainfall** was reported in





Rangpur, Sylhet, Barguna. **Embankments collapsed** in Rajbari, Khulna, Gopalganj, Sirajganj, Jamalpur. **Waterlogging** was reported in Rangpur, Satkhira, Tangail district. **Wildlife inflicted damage** was reported in Gaibandha, unknown animal kept attacking people and injuring them. **Wall collapsed** in Chandpur, Faridpur, Gazipur, Rajshahi and 3 people were reported dead in the incidents.

Description of Hazard Incidents in October 2021

Covid-19 Pandemic in Bangladesh

The number of newly identified patients with Covid-19 was **13,628** from 1st October to 31st October 2021. In this month **17,482** persons recovered and total death was **358** which indicates both the number of deaths and the confirmed case is declining. From the very first case identified on March 8, 2021, the total number of Covid-19 patients is **15,69,653** among which **27,870** persons died and **15,33,625** persons recovered up to November 2nd, 2021. Lightning

Lightning cases were reported in 16 districts. Among them Jamalpur, Thakurgaon, Kishorganj had the highest number of casualties. A total of 35 people lost their lives, another 7 were injured. Majority of casualties were of the farmers working in open spaces and Fishermen catching fish in large water bodies. 4 cows died in different cases and losses of tk 3 lacs (Jugantor.com 12-October 21). See annex 2 for more details.

Flood

Flood caused widespread damage in the second half of October, 2021. 6 districts reported heavy damage e.g. Rangpur, Lalmanirhat, Kurigram, Tangail, Gaibandha, Faridpur. More than 60 kilometers of land reported being flooded, 38,438 families and 1,55,252 individuals were affected according to [NDRCC](#) reports, and more than 108 educational and religious institutes were also damaged because of the flood. Boat Capsize

In 4 districts, all over Bangladesh, namely Dhaka, Pabna, Manikganj, Brahmanbaria boat capsized occurred. 9 people died and 14 people were reported missing. A ferry from Paturia Ghat, Manikganj capsized and 17 trucks and 7 motor bikes reported drowned. Further Details regarding Boat Capsize are given below.

Fire

According to the NDRCC report of October 2021 and different dailies, 404 fire incidents took place around the country. Dhaka division Reported the highest number of fire incidents (157), Followed by Chattogram division (74), Khulna division (44), Rangpur division (34), Mymensingh division (27), Rajshahi division (27), Barisal division (22) and Sylhet division (19). Among the 404 incidents 20 were reported in which 1 people died, 6 people were injured. More than 40 shops are burnt. See more details in **Annex 3 & 5**.

Riverbank Erosion

Riverbank erosion affected with loss of properties, croplands as well as crops. 4 districts in total reported riverbank erosion namely Satkhira, Gopalganj, Faridpur, Kushtia respectively. In total 300 houses, 1 mosque, 20-30 shops from 22 different union were washed away. Details of the riverbank erosion impacts were addressed in the below table.

Embankment Collapse

In October, 2021, total 5 districts reported embankment damage; these were Rajbari, Khulna, Gopalganj, Sirajganj, Jamalpur. Around 950 meters of embankment reported being damaged in addition unknown figure of numbers of Aman land, 50 fish pond, 22 shops have been washed away.

Waterlogging

A total of 8 waterlogging incidents were reported in daily newspapers. In Rangpur, Satkhira, Tangail faced massive waterlogging due to heavy rain and 50,000 people from 8,000 families from 47 villages in Satkhira had been water logged for months.

Heavy Rainfall

Several incidents of heavy rainfall occurred in October 2021. At Rangpur station 195 m.m. at Pateshwari station 140 m.m. and Chatak station recorded 137m.m. of rainfall according to the NDRCC report of 04-October 2021. Borguna station recorded 158m.m. and Chandpur recorded 101m.m. of rainfall on October 19th according to the NDRCC report. Both Dalia, Thakurgaon station recorded 110m.m. and Panchagar station recorded 108m.m. of rainfall on October 20th according to NDRCC.

Bridge Collapse

Guide wall of a bridge has been damaged due to heavy rainfall and partially collapsed in Jessore. www.kalerkantho.com 6-oct 21.

Wildlife Inflicted Damage

In Palashbari, Gaibandha, unknown wild animal attacked several people killing 1 person and injurung at least 11. source www.prothomalo.com 29-oct 2021.

Wall Collapse

GoB Response in October 2021

Response to Covid-19 up to October 30, 2021: The government managed to vaccinate 1st dose of covid-19 vaccines till 31th October 2021, to 4,21,54,848 (WHO) people starting from January 27, 2021. From April 08, 2021, to October 2021, a total of 2,92,37,863 2nd doses vaccines were administered. As of 31st October 12,719 general beds, 1,064 Intensive care unit (ICU) beds are available in the hospitals across the country, reports in dedicated government website for covid-19.

Response to Lightning: In 2 districts, the government allocated and distributed a total of BDT 80,000 to the families of the deceased in October, 2021. See more details in the table below:

Response to Flood: 5,00,000 taka and 70 MT GR rice have been allocated to 5 upazilas of Lalmanirhat district on 21st October ([NDRCC Disaster situation report](#), October 21, 2021). As well, Rangpur and kurigram district received an allocation of 8,00,000 taka each, on the other hand, Nilphamari and Lalmanirhat district had allocation of 10,00,000 taka each. Total 36,00,000 taka have been allocated on October 24th according to the [NDRCC Disaster Situation Report](#) of 25th October 2021.

Conclusion

A total of 12 hazards took place this month with multiple casualties of life and assets across the country. These incidents caused a huge loss of lives and properties and disrupted daily activities. Govt. took initiatives to minimize the losses and also undertook necessary steps to provide support to the distressed people.
