




Overview of Hazard Incidences in December 2022

In December 2022, **eight** types of hazard incidents occurred across Bangladesh, including, **Covid-19**, **Cold-Wave, Dengue, Diarrhoea, Fire, Landslide, Riverbank Erosion, and Wild Animal Attack.** On the basis of the DGHS daily situation report, dengue was less severe in December 2022 with compare the month of November 2022. It caused the death of **27**people and **5,233** confirmed cases were identified throughout **54** districts in this month. **Covid-19** affected a total number of **528** people in **24** districts in the month of December 2022. According to the national report published by DGHS in December 2022, due to **Covid-19**, only **seven** people have died and **1,834** recovered. The devastating activities of covid-19 was decreased with compare to the month of November 2022. With reference to the daily hazard situation report of MoDMR and DDM, a total of **878** Fire incidents took place in 17 districts, resulting in the deaths of **six** people and injuring 15 people. 18 houses, 219 shops, one sugar refinery factory, and two warehouses were burnt due to fire incidences in the month of December 2022. The estimated losses were 2 crores and 31 lac taka.

A **landslide** event took place on 7th December 2022 at Ramu upazila, Cox's Bazar district where four people died in the same family. 1171 **Diarrhoea** patients were identified in five districts namely Nilphamari, Madaripur, Chapai Nawabganj, Chuadanga, and Satkhira in December 2022. One event of **Riverbank Erosion** took place in the Pirujpur district resulted three shops being washed away into the river. One person died in the **Wild Elephant Attack** at Durgapur upazila in Netrokona district on 7th December 2022. A mild **Cold-Wave** was blown among eight districts i.e. Jeshore, Chuadanga, Pabna, Sylhet, Panchagarh, Naogaon, Nilphamari, and Rajshahi districts from 29th December to 31st December. The minimum temperature was recorded at 8.5 degrees Celsius during the Cold-Wave situation. No casualties were recorded during hazardous situations.


Covid-19


The number of newly identified patients with Covid-19 was **528** from 1st December to 31 December 2022. In this month 1,834 people recovered, and the total death was only seven which indicates both the number of deaths. and the confirmed cases have decreased compared to the previous month. From the very first case identified on March 8, 2020, the total number of Covid-19 patients is 2,037,125 among which 29,440 persons died and 19,87,733 persons recovered from **1,51,71,208** tested samples in total up to 31 December-2022, according to DGHS.


See Annex 1 for more details on the month of December. Graph 2 depicted the overall scenario of covid -19 from January 2022 to December 2022. The number of confirmed case and the number of death are decreased. The total number of death in 2022 was only 1362 with compare recent two years. The highest death was noticed in February month while the lowest is noticed in December. Total confirmed case also less than the year of 2020 and 2021 in the year of 2022.

Dengue

Dengue case is decreasing before the previous month. In December, just **54** districts suffered from dengue, and as usual, Dhaka has the highest confirmed cases (**2,717**) and deaths (**18**). In November where the number of confirmed cases was **19,334** while in December it went down to **5,233** confirmed cases and the death toll decreased from **113** to **27** people. Graph 3 illustrate the overall scenario of dengue in Bangladesh for the year of 2022. The fatalities were increased since July and packed the highest in November







month than again started to decrease. Basically during the monsoon season the causalities are most severe compare than other season in Bangladesh. See the details in Annex 2.

Fire

According to the <u>NDRCC</u> report and different dailies, 878 fire incidents took place across the country in December 2022. Dhaka division reported the highest number of fire incidents (266), followed by Rajshahi division (189), Chattogram division (102), Rangpur division (101), Khulna (98), Mymensingh division (60), Sylhet division (47) and Barishal division (15). Among the 878 incidents, six person died, 14 injured


and several property damages were recorded. The estimated loss was recorded around 2 crores and 31 lacs taka. For more details, see in Annex 4.

Cold Wave

A mild **Clod Wave** was blown through 8 districts namely Rajshahi, Sylhet, Jashore, Naogaon, Chuadanga, Pabna, Panchagarh and Nilphamarui from 29 December to 31 December 2022. No causalities were recorded due to this cold wave. The minimum temperature was recorded 8.5 degree Celsius at Chuadanga during cold wave situations. <u>31 December 2022. DDM</u>. The daily minimum temperature showed a negative trend from the beginning of december to the end of december (<u>Graph 2</u>).



Landslide

A landslide event took place at Ramu upazila Cox's Bazar district on 7th December 2022 where four people were died in same family at early night. <u>prothomalo.com.</u>

Diarrhoea

The districts that have been plagued with diarrhoea in December 2022, are Nilphamari, Madaripur, Chapai Nawabganj, Chuadanga, and Satkhira. 1171 patients with severe diarrhoea cases were admitted into hospitals. See the details in **Annex 3**.

Riverbank Erosion

Riverbank Erosion has been occurred at Pirojpur district Sarupkathi upazila where three shops were washed away due to erosion of riverbank. three shops have been collapsed. samakal.com 27 December 2022

Wild Animal Attack

Conclusion

A total **eight** types **of** hazard took place in December 2022 with multiple casualties of life and assets across the country. These incidents caused a huge loss of lives and properties and disrupted daily activities. The government took initiatives to minimize the losses and also undertook necessary steps to provide support to the distressed people.
