



### Overview of Hazard Incidences in April 2023

In April 2023, Eleven types of hazard incidents occurred across Bangladesh, including, Boat Capsized, Bridge Collapse, Covid-19, Dengue, Fire, Heat Wave, Lightening, Nor'wester, Riverbank Erosion, Wall Collapse, and Wild Animal Attacks. According to the daily newspaper, 18 Lightning events occurred in sixteen districts which caused 26 people to die from different age and gender groups. Three incidents of Boat Capsized occurred in 3 districts including Lalmonirhat, Narayangani, and Patuakhali districts. Due to these incidents, six people died and one person was missing in the districts. With reference to the daily hazard situation report of MoDMR and DDM, a total of 970 Fire incidents took place in 17 districts, resulting in five death, sixty-two injured, and 9,095 shops, one warehouse, and 63 houses were burnt, etc. due to Fire incidences in April 2023. The estimated losses were 1,004 crores 20 lakh and 50 thousand takas. Based on the DGHS daily situation report, **Dengue** was slightly more severe in April 2023 with compare to March 2023. It caused the **death** of **five** people, and **143** confirmed cases were identified throughout **11** districts this month. Three events of the Wild Elephant Attacks happened in Mymensingh and Sherpur districts respectively on the 14th, 22nd, and 28th of April 2023. two people were killed by a Wild Elephant Attack in the mentioned districts. On the other hand, a wall collapse incident occurred in Madaripur district. During this incident, one child died and four were injured. A Bridge collapsed in Mymensingh which caused a car damaged and three people injured. In the district of Shariatpur, one incident of Riverbank Erosion occurred which resulted in of 100-meter embankment collapse due to erosion. In this month, seven nor 'wester incidents hit Patuakhali, Bagerhat, Cox's Bazar, Dhaka, Satkhira, Mymensingh, and Gazipur districts which caused damage to 1050 houses, 100 shops, 1,000 tin-roofed structures, 200 hectares of land at the affected areas. Covid-19 affected a total number of 204 people in 7 districts in April 2023. According to the national report published by DGHS in April 2023, due to Covid-19, no death is reported and 108 recovered. The devastating activity of Covid-19 decreased compared to March 2023, but the infected rate slightly increased in April compared to March 2023. Besides, the country has experienced a total of 29 different levels of heat wave in 64 four districts where Mild, mild to moderate, and extreme heat wave was 3, 2, and 1 respectively. The maximum temperature was recorded at 43 degrees Celsius at Ishdardi (Pabna) during heat wave situations on 18 April 2023. No casualties were recorded due to the heat wave.

## Description of Hazard Incidents in April 2023

#### **Boat Capsized**


Three incidents of **Boat Capsized** happened in three districts i.e., Lalmonirhat, Narayanganj, and Patuakhali on several dates in April 2023. Due to Boat Capsized, **six** people **died** and **one** person was **missing** in these districts. Besides, on 23rd April an incident occurred in Lalmonirhat where **one** person was missing (bd-protein). An adolescent girl **died** in the Narayanganj district on 28<sup>th</sup> April (jagonews24). In Patuakhali, **five** people **died** on 30 April (jagonews24).

### **Bridge Collapse**

A steel **Bridge Collapsed** after a **42**-wheeler carrying a transformer got on it on the Dhaka-Mymensingh highway in Trishal Upazila. As a result of this incident, a car was damaged and **three** people were **injured** (dhakatribune).

#### Covid-19

The number of newly identified patients with Covid-19 has 204 from 1<sup>st</sup> April to 30<sup>th</sup> April 2023. In this month 108 people have **recovered**, and no death which indicates both the number of death and the confirmed cases have decreased compared to March. The total number of confirmed cases has 2038232 from the first identification of Covid-19 in Bangladesh in March 2020. The total death and recovered to the end of April was 29446 and 2005546 respectively DGHS. See the details in Annex 1 for more details information.



### **Dengue**

Based on <u>DGHS</u> daily situation report, the confirmed cases and death of **Dengue** increased in April month compared with March month. In April, just **11 districts** suffered from dengue, and as usual, **Dhaka** has the highest number of confirmed cases (**92**) and deaths (**2**). Secondly, the Chattogram district confirms cases (**22**) and deaths (**3**). In April the total number of confirmed cases are **143** and a total of **five** people died whereas in March it was lower compared to April. See the details in <u>Annex 2</u>

#### Fire

According to the NDRCC report and different dailies, 970 fire incidents took place across the country in April 2023. Dhaka division reported the highest number of fire incidents (284), followed by Khulna division (202), Rajshahi division (119), Rangpur division (117), Chattogram division, (116), Mymensingh division (62), Barishal division (34), Sylhet (36). Among the 970 incidents, five people died, sixty-two were injured, and several property damages were recorded such as shops, tin shed shops, houses, CNG, family's houses, etc. The estimated losses were recorded as approximately 1,004 crores 20 lakh and 50 thousand takas. 

#### Heatwave

This month, there were six **Heat Wave** events, **one extreme heatwave** occurred between **14** to **21** April, **two mild to moderate** heat wave events from **9** to **22** April and **28**<sup>th</sup> April, and **three mild** heat wave events from **5** to **8** April **26**<sup>th</sup> to **27**<sup>th</sup> April, and **30** April was blown throughout the country. The first one was a **mild heat** 

wave that occurred in five districts namely Faridpur, Rajshahi, Pabna, Jessore, Chuadanga, and Khustia. respectively and the heat wave in different categories was continuous in districts. Besides, Dinajpur, 64 Rajshahi, Pabna, Chuadanga, Khustia, and Jessore districts have experienced an extreme heat wave this month. The maximum temperature was recorded at 43 degrees Celsius at Ishdardi during heat wave situations, on 18 April 2023 (DDM).



The daily maximum temperature showed a negative trend in April with compare to March 2023. More details in <u>Annex-4</u>

#### **Lightning**

This month, **18 Lightning** incidents are recorded which resulted in the cause of death toll of **26** people and **four** livestock, and **seven** people were injured. There were **16** districts namely Sylhet, Netrokona, Sunamganj, Moulovibazar, Satkhira, Jessore, Jhenaidah, Rajbari, Chapainawabganj, Meherpur Pabna, Sirajganj and Pirojpur where lightning event recorded. More details are in <u>Annex 5.</u>

### Nor' wester

Seven incidents of nor 'wester took place on the 3<sup>rd</sup>, 23<sup>rd</sup>, and 27<sup>th</sup> of April in Patuakhali, Bagerhat, Cox's Bazar, Dhaka, Satkhira, Mymensingh, and Gazipur districts respectively. 50 houses were damaged at Baufal in Patuakhali (thedailystar) and damaged at least 1,000 houses, over 100 shops, and a few mosques, damaged over 1.000 tin-roofed structures, including dwelling houses, shops, and mosques, damaged boro and maize plants on around 200 hectares of land at the affected villages at Kochua in Bagerhat (thedailystar). On the other hand, A nor 'wester resulted in disruption of Electricity, and water logging due to construction work in Cox's Bazar (Daily Inqilab). More details are in Annex 6

#### **Riverbank Erosion**

Based on different national dailies, **Riverbank Erosion** occurred in the Shariatpur district at Shariatpur Sadar on 14 April 2023 where **100** meters of embankment collapsed and **five** houses were washed in the river (prothomalo)

#### Wall collapse

One incident of Wall Collapse occurred on 13th April 2023 at Sadar upazila in Madaripur where one child

**died** and **four** were injured (prothomalo)

#### **Wild Animal Attack**

Three Wild Animal Attack events took place on several dates in April month which resulted in **two** deaths and **one** injured. On 14<sup>th</sup> April a wild elephant attacked in Sherpur district Sreebardi upazila which resulted in **one** person dying and **one** person injured (<u>Prothom Alo</u>). On 22nd April 2023, some elephants attacked crops land at Haluaghat Upazila in Mymensingh where **one** farmer died and many crops were damaged (<u>Prothom Alo</u>). On the other hand, a wild elephant attack on 28<sup>th</sup> April 2023 at Nalitabari in Sherpur district resulted in **24** thousand saplings and **50** decimals of the rice cultivated area damaged.

# GoB Response

#### **Response to Boat Capsized**

On 30<sup>th</sup> April a boat capsized event in Doshmina upazila in Patuakhali district, Upazila Executive Officer (UNO) Nafisa Naz Neera said that the government is giving support of **Tk 20,000** per person for the burial of the deceased (jagonews24).

#### **Response to Fire**

On 4<sup>th</sup> April 2023, after the fire incident in Ramna, Dhaka, State Minister for Disaster said, this fire is terrible. Now those who have been injured will be compensated Rs **15,000**. He also said that **14.5** kg of food will be given to the affected businessmen. He said this will include rice, dal, oil, and spices (prothomalo).

#### **Response to Wild Animal Attack**

On 22<sup>nd</sup> April 2023 and 28<sup>th</sup> April after a wild animal attack in Haluaghat and Nalitabari of Mymensingh (Prothom Alo) and Sherpur 3 lakh BDT has given by the government and to protect elephants from attack local Government gave lamp and torch to the farmer respectively (Prothom Alo).

### Conclusion

A total of **Eleven types of** hazards took place in April 2023 with multiple casualties of life and assets across the country. These incidents caused a huge loss of lives and properties and disrupted daily activities.
