




Overview of Hazard Incidences in May 2023

In May 2023, twelve types of hazard incidents occurred across Bangladesh, including, Boat Capsized, Bridge Collapse, Covid-19, Cyclone, Dengue, Fire, Heat Wave, Land Slide, Lightening, Nor 'wester, Riverbank Erosion, and Wild Animal Attacks. According to the daily newspaper 28 Lightning incidents are recorded which resulted in the cause of death toll of 37 people and 20 people were injured. With reference to the daily hazard situation report of MoDMR and DDM, a total 714 fire incidents took place across the country in May resulting in Eight people died, fourteen were injured, and several property damages were recorded such as shops, houses, family's houses, etc. The estimated losses were recorded as approximately 70 lakhs. Five Wild Animal Attack events took place on several dates in May which resulted in five deaths in different districts namely Mymensingh, Sherpur, Moulvibazar, Rangamati, Bandarban districts. On the other hand, one incident of Land Slide occurred at Sadarpur upazila in Faridpur where three workers were killed, and four others injured after the landslide. Based on the DGHS daily situation report, the confirmed cases and death of **Dengue** increased in May compared with April month. In May, just 9 districts suffered from dengue, and as usual Dhaka district reported the highest dengue infected patients. In May a total of 235 confirmed case was identified and total death toll was two. According to sDDM, a total of 4 districts, 26 Upazilas (sub-districts), 99 unions, and 429,337 Bangladeshi nationals were affected by the cyclone Mocha. A Bridge Collapsed happened at Pirgacha upazila in Rangpur resulted communication system disruption and it disconnected 250,000 people from 60 villages across five unions in Pirgacha upazila. One incident of Boat Capsized happened in Rajbari district. Due to Boat Capsized, about 1 lakh taka loss was reported. In the district of Shariatpur and Pirojpur, two incidents of Riverbank Erosion occurred which caused many infrastructural, crops land damages. In this month, three nor 'wester incidents hit in Dhaka and Rangpur and Satkhira. In Rangpur about **One** thousand houses were damaged and many plants were uprooted at Pirgacha and Kaunia Upazila of the district. Covid-19 affected a total number of 110 people in 20 districts in May 2023. According to the national report published by DGHS in May 2023, due to Covid-19 no death is reported and 613 recovered. Besides, the country has experienced a total of four different levels of heat wave in 64 districts where mild, mild to moderate, and extreme heat wave. The maximum temperature was recorded at 41.2 degrees Celsius at Chuadanga during heat wave situations on 9 May 2023. No casualties were recorded due to the heat wave.

Description of Hazard Incidents in May 2023

Boat Capsized


One incident of **Boat Capsized** happened in Rajbari district on 18 May 2023. Due to Boat Capsized, about one lakh taka loss was reported (prothomalo).

Bridge Collapse

A **Bridge Collapsed** happened at Pirgcha upazila in Rangpur on 30 May in 2023. As a result of this incident, the communication system was suspended, and it disconnected **250,000** people from **60** villages across five unions in Pirgacha upazila. On the other hand, farmers cannot travel to markets for purchasing essential supplies such as seeds and fertilizers (dhakatribune).

Covid-19

The number of newly identified patients with Covid-19 has 110 from 1st May to 31st May 2023. In this month 613 people have recovered, and no death which indicates both the number of death and the confirmed cases have decreased compared to April. The total number of confirmed cases has 2039347 from the first Covid-19 identification of in Bangladesh in March 2020. The total death and recovered to the end of 29446 and 2006267 April was



respectively DGHS. See the details in Annex1 for more details information.

Cyclone

According to the Department of Disaster Management (DDM) and the Ministry of Disaster Management and Relief (MoDMR) several damages were caused by Cyclone Mocha. The assessment revealed that a total of 4 districts, 26 Upazilas (sub-districts), 99 unions, and 429,337 Bangladeshi nationals were affected by the cyclone. The damage assessment identified 2,052 fully damaged houses and 10,692 partially damaged houses. 703 acres of cropland have been destroyed. On the other hand, according to the Department of Public Health Engineering (DPHE) primarily in Teknaf, 11,555 latrines and 266 water points have been damaged. The volume of solid waste has also increased due to debris, fallen branches, and damaged infrastructure.

Dengue

Based on <u>DGHS</u> daily situation report, the confirmed cases and death of **Dengue** increased in May compared with April month. In May, just **24 districts** suffered from dengue, and as usual, **Dhaka** has the highest number of confirmed cases (**864**) and deaths (**2**). Secondly, the Chattogram district confirms cases (**81**). In May the total number of confirmed cases are **1037** and a total of **2** people died whereas in April it was lower compared to May. Fire

According to the <u>NDRCC</u> report and different dailies, **714** fire incidents took place across the country in May 2023. Dhaka division reported the highest number of fire incidents (**182**), followed by Chattogram division (**113**), Rangpur division (**107**), Khulna division (**94**), Mymensingh division, (**79**), Rajshahi division (**67**), Sylhet division (**37**), Barishal Division (**35**). Among the **714** incidents, **eight** people **died**, **fourteen** were **injured**, and several property damages were recorded such as shops, houses, family's houses, etc. The


estimated losses were recorded as approximately **70 lakhs**. For more details, see Annex 3 and the below table.

Heatwave

This month, there were a total of four Wave events. Mild to one Moderate and extreme heatwave occurred between 7 to 17 May, one mild to moderate heat wave events on from **30-31** May, and **two** mild form 1-3 May and 20-24 May heatwave was blown throughout the country. The first one was a mild heat wave that occurred in four districts namely Chottogram, Rangamati, Feni, Barisal respectively and the heat wave in different categories continuous in districts. Besides, Rajshahi, Netrokona, Khulna, Chudanga, Kustia,



Patuakhali, Pabna, Bagura, Dinajpur, Nilphamari districts have experienced an extreme heat wave this month. The maximum temperature was recorded at **41.2** degrees Celsius at **Chuadanga** during heat wave situations, on **9**th **May 2023** (DDM). The daily maximum temperature showed a negative trend in May compared to April 2023. More details in Annex-4

Land Slide

One incident of **Land Slide** occurred on **31**st May 2023 at Sadarpur upazila in Faridpur where Three workers were killed and four others injured after a landslide <u>dailystar</u>.

Lightning

This month, **28 Lightning** incidents are recorded which resulted in the cause of death toll of **37** people and and **20** people were injured. There were **22** districts namely Netrokona, Sunamganj, Moulovibazar, Hobigonj, Rajbari, Narsingdi, Chapainawabganj, Pabna, Sirajganj, Pirojpur, Bogura, Gazipur, Cox's Bazar, Bramhanbaria, Munsigonj, Magura, Kurigram, Chandpur, Gopalgonj, Mymensingh, Mongla, Naogaon where lightning event recorded. More details are in <u>Annex 5</u>.

Nor' wester

Three incidents of nor 'wester took place on the 16th and 24th May 2023 in Dhaka, Rangpur and Satkhira respectively. In Rangpur about One thousand houses were damaged and many plants were uprooted at

Pirgacha and Kaunia Upazila of the district (<u>bd-pratidin</u>). On the other hand, In Dhaka no casualties were reported due to nor' wester (<u>prothomalo</u>). At Asassuni Upazila of Satkhira Districts, **some houses were damaged** and **many trees** were **uprooted** during nor 'wester on 24th May 2023 <u>dainikdristipat</u>.

Riverbank Erosion

Based on different national dailies, **Riverbank Erosion** occurred in the Bogura and Pirojpur districts. At Sariakandi Upazila of Bogura Districts, 15 houses and 1 hector cultivated land were disappeared in the Jumuna river (<u>prothomalo</u>). On the other hand, due to the river bank erosion markets, roads and feri has been disappearing in the river (<u>prothomalo</u>).

Wild Animal Attack

Five Wild Animal Attack events took place on several dates in May which resulted in **five** deaths in different districts. On 1st May 2023 a wild elephant attacked in Sherpur district Sreebardi upazila which resulted in **one** person dying and **one** person injured (<u>prothomalo</u>). On 2nd May 2023, some elephants attacked at Haluaghat Upazila in Mymensingh where **one** farmer died (<u>prothomalo</u>). On the other hand, two wild elephants attacked on 7th May 2023 at Juri and Lama in Moulovibazar and Bandarban respectively which resulted **two** people died (<u>dhakatribune</u>), (<u>prothomalo</u>). On 29th May 2023, a member of the village defense force died in an attack by a wild elephant at Barkal Upazila in Rangamati dhakatribune.

GoB Response

Response to Lightning

In Magura District after a lightning incident Local administration allocated Tk25,000 each to the victims' families on 10th May 2023 <u>dhakatribune</u>. On 23rd May 2023, upazila administration of Nasirnagar in Brahmanbaria gave Tk25,000 to the family of the deceased <u>dhakatribune</u>. After a lightning event at Modon upazila administration gave Tk20,000 to the family of the deceased <u>samakal</u>.

Conclusion

A total of **Twelve types of** hazards took place in May 2023 with multiple casualties of life and assets across the country. These incidents caused a huge loss of lives and properties and disrupted daily activities.
