




Overview of Hazard Incidences in June 2023

In June 2023, thirteen types of hazard incidents occurred across Bangladesh, including, Boat Capsized, Covid-19. Dengue, Embankment collapse, Fire, Heat Wave, Land Slide, Lightening, Nor 'wester, Riverbank Erosion, Wall collapse, Waterlogging and Wild Animal Attacks. Based on the DGHS daily situation report, the confirmed cases and death of **Dengue** increased in June compared with May month and it is increasing drastically. In this month it spread about 59 Districts of Bangladesh and total confirmed cases were 5956 identified and 4916 were recovered where total death was 34 in June. According to the daily newspaper 24 Lightning incidents are recorded which resulted in the cause of death toll of 28 people and 4 cows died in different districts. On the other hand, some furniture was burned which resulted in a 40thousand-taka BDT loss. With reference to the daily hazard situation report of MoDMR and DDM, the 488 fire incidents, twenty-three people died, three livestock died 69 people were injured, five houses, eleven shops, and several property damages were recorded such as many furniture, cloths, and other goods were burned, etc. The estimated losses were recorded as approximately 20 lakhs. The number of newly identified patients with Covid-19 has 3249 in June 2023. In this month 2585 people have recovered, and 16 death which indicates both the number of death and the confirmed cases have increased compared to May. Four incidents of **Boat Capsized** happened in different districts which caused total **five** people died, 15 people injured and missing 28 cows in different districts. However, total three people died because of three wall collapse incidents in different places. Three Wild Animal Attack events took place on several dates in June which resulted in one death and different resources damaged in different districts. On the other hand, one incident of Land Slide occurred at Ukhiya upazila in Cox's Bazar where one Rohingya worker died. Based on different national dailies, Riverbank Erosion occurred in several districts of Bangladesh which resulted more than 293 houses, 50 trees and lots of land have been swept away by the river, 500 feet concrete road collapsed into the river due to the severe erosion and more than **five thousand** families were waterlogged. In addition, waterlogging occurred in several districts of Bangladesh. As a result of the incident, 20 trees were uprooted on the road and schools, colleges, and hospitals were also affected. One incident of nor 'wester took place in Gaibandha where two students were injured during the nor' wester. An embankment of the river of kurigram collapsed where some low laying areas were inundated by water. Besides, the country has experienced a total of 2 different levels of heat wave throughout the country where mild to moderate, and extreme heat wave blowing. The maximum temperature was recorded at 41.6 degrees Celsius at Dinajpur.


Description of Hazard Incidents in June 2023

Boat Capsized

Four incidents of **Boat Capsized** happened in different districts which caused total **five** people died, 15 people injured and missing 28 cows. In Brammanbaria **one** Child (3) Died and **15** Passengers were injured on 7th June 2023 <u>prothomalo</u>. On the other hand, in Bogura Boat and some accessories are lost in the river on 18 June 2023 <u>jugantor</u>. **28** Cow missing **four** People died in Manikganj, Chapainawabganj districts on 4 June and 8 June 2023 respectively (<u>bhorerkagoj</u>), (thefinancialexpress). Covid-19

The number of newly identified patients with Covid-19 has 3249 from 1st June to 30st June 2023. In this month 2585 people have recovered, and 16 death which indicates both the number of death and the confirmed cases have increased compared to May. The total number of confirmed cases has 2042592 from the first identification of Covid-19 in Bangladesh in March 2020. The total death and recovered to the end of June was 29462 and 2008852 respectively DGHS. See the details in Annex 2 for more details information.



Dengue

Based on <u>DGHS</u> daily situation report, the confirmed cases and death of **Dengue** increased in June compared with May month. In June, most of the districts suffered from dengue, and as usual, **Dhaka** has the highest number of confirmed cases (4729) and deaths (27). Secondly, the Chattogram district confirms cases (290) and deaths (6). In June the total number of confirmed cases are 5956 and a total of 34 people died whereas in May it was lower compared to June. In this month it spread about 59 Districts of Bangladesh. See the details in <u>Annex 3</u>.

Embankment Collapse

On 21June 2023, incident of embankment collapse happened in kurigram district at Nageshwari which resulted inundation of the low-lying areas at the upazila (observerbd).

Fire

According to the NDRCC report and different dailies, **488** fire incidents took place across the country in May 2023. Dhaka division reported the highest number of fire incidents (**134**), followed by Rajshahi division (**77**) Chattogram division (**69**), Khulna division (**58**), Rangpur division (**56**), Mymensingh division, (**51**), Sylhet division (**22**), Barishal Division (**21**). Among the **488** incidents, **twenty-three** people died, **three** livestock died **69** people were injured, **five** houses, **eleven** shops, **and** several property damages were recorded such as many furniture, cloths, and other goods were burned, etc. The estimated losses were recorded as approximately **20** lakhs. 

Total: twenty-three people died, three livestock died sixty-nine people were injured, five houses, eleven shops, and several property damages were recorded such as many furniture, cloths, and other goods were burned, etc. The estimated losses were recorded as approximately 20 lakhs

Heatwave

According to NDRCC in this month, there were a total of **2 Heat Wave** events, **one** is **mild to moderate** occurred between **1** to **10** June, **one mild to moderate** and **extreme** heat wave event from 12-18 June. The maximum temperature was recorded at **41.6** degrees Celsius at **Dinajpur** during heat wave situations, on **3rd June 2023**. The daily maximum temperature showed a positive trend in June compared to May 2023. More details in Annex **5**.



Land Slide

One incident of **Land Slide** occurred on **28**th **June** 2023 at Ukhiya upazila in Cox's Bazar where **one** Rohingya worker died (<u>observerbd</u>).

Lightning

This month, **24 Lightning** incidents are recorded which resulted in the cause of death toll of **28** people and 4 cows died in different districts. On the other hand, some furniture was burned which resulted in a **40**-thousand-taka BDT loss. There were **16** districts namely Sunamganj, Moulovibazar, Sirajganj, Bramhanbaria, Naogaon, Dinajpur, Noakhali, Joypurhat, Rangamati, Khulna, Satkhira, Tangail, Panchagarh, Jhenaidah, Rajshahi, Bogura where lightning event recorded. More details are in Annex **6**.

Nor' wester

One incident of nor 'wester took place on the 8 June 2023 in Gaibandha. In this incident two students were injured during the nor' wester kalerkantho.

Riverbank Erosion

Based on different national dailies, **Riverbank Erosion** occurred in Sirajganj, Sunamganj, Jamalpur, Bogra, Tangail, Lalmonirhat, Rangpur, Kurigram districts at different upazila which resulted more than **293** houses, **50** trees and lots of land have been swept away by the river, **500** feet concrete road collapsed into the river due to the severe erosion. On the hand rising water inundates low-lying areas and causes riverbanks to crumble, Shortage of drinking water, crops lands are submerged in water and more than **five thousand** families are waterlogged. In Sirajgonj more than **50** houses, many trees and lots of land have been swept away by the river and **23** houses have been lost to the river with a significant portion of croplands being submerged bd-pratidin. Besides, in sunamgonj, a **500** feet concrete road collapsed into the river due to the severe erosion dhakatribune. **50** trees along with **170** houses, **hundreds** of acres of farmland have lost, Houses, croplands, roads, and other establishment swept away by the river in Jamalpur dailynayadiganta, and **23 houses** have

been lost to the river with a significant portion of croplands being submerged in Bogura. Furthermore, over **50** houses and roads have been damaged in Tangail. Apart from this incident another incident of riverbank erosion occurred in Kurigram where many houses, several hundred hectares of cropland and a school were affected by riverbank erosion. More details in Annex 7.

Wall Collapse

There were **three** incidents of wall collapse that happened in June 2023 in different districts. Total **three** people were died for these incidents. In Gopalganj district **one** Worker Died and 2 injured at Sadar upazila (<u>kalerkantho</u>) and **one** Child died in Barishal district (<u>bd-pratidin</u>). On the other hand, in Cox's Bazar **one** child died because of wall collapse.

Waterlogging

Based on different national dailies, **waterlogging** occurred in Chattogram, Tangail, Dhaka, Sylhet, Nilphamari, Chattogram, Habiganj, Moulvibazar, Brahmanbaria at different upazila. In chottogram, because of the waterlogging a temporary communication disruption happened in the low-lying areas of the city. In Dhaka, 20 trees were uprooted on the road and schools, colleges, hospitals were also affected by waterlogging in different date in different places (bd-pratidin) (dailynayadiganta). Wild Animal Attack

Three Wild Animal Attack events took place on several dates in June which resulted in **one** death and different resources damaged in different districts. On 6th June 2023 a wild elephant attacked in Sherpur district Nalitabari upazila which resulted houses and firm destruction (<u>prothomalo</u>). On 7th June 2023, some elephants attacked at Pekua Upazila in Cox's Bazar where **one** person died (<u>prothomalo</u>). On the other hand, in Bandarban at Lama Upazila hundreds of trees were uprooted and more than **10** lakh taka were damaged by an elephant attack (<u>samakal</u>).

GoB Response

Response to Waterlogging

In Dhaka district during a waterlogging incident on 28 June 2023, Dhaka City Corporation Quick Response team Clear all the uprooted trees from the roads (dailynayadiganta).

Response to Riverbank Erison

On 5 June 2023, Sirajganj Water Development Board has been throwing geo bags for a few days to prevent breakage (<u>alokitobangladesh</u>). Geo bags placed by Bangladesh Water Development Board (BWDB) to protect the embankment has also eroded in Tangail (thedailystar).

Conclusion

A total of **Thirteen types of** hazards took place in June 2023 with multiple casualties of life and assets across the country. These incidents caused a huge loss of lives and properties and disrupted daily activities.
