

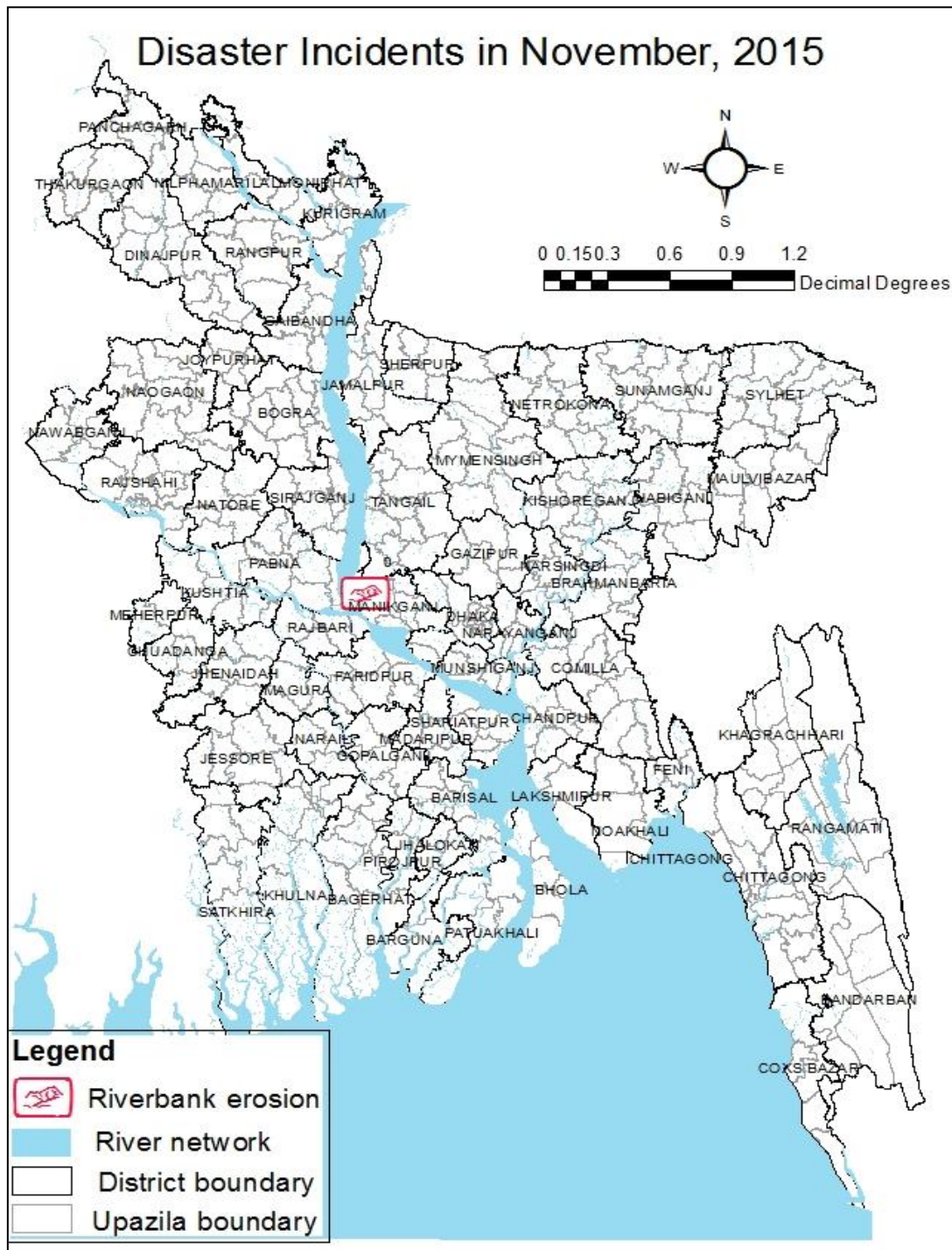


Overview of Disaster Incidences in November 2015

Riverbank erosion that started in October in Manikganj continued until November 2. Some 200 houses, 300 acres of cultivatable land and several educational institutions have been devoured by the river Padma.
